RESOLUTION NO. 35-14

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF
FREE BEACH BADGES TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Borough of Cape May Point enacted Ordinance No. 06-2014 providing exemptions from beach badge fees for certain members of the United States Military; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 06-2014 authorized regulations and procedures for this program to be set forth by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Cape May Point, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey that the regulations and procedures set forth herein for the issuance of free beach badges are hereby approved:

- 1) Eligible Branches of Service:
 - a. United States Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps.
 - b. United States Coast Guard.
 - c. United States Army and Air National Guard.


- 2) Active in Service:
 - a. Active personnel, spouse/civil union partner, and dependent children over the age of twelve (12) are eligible for free beach badges.
 - b. Qualifying Active Personnel must be present at the time of the request.
 - c. Proper, non-expired military identification must be presented and completion of the Cape May Point tracking form is required.
 - d. Only one set of free beach badges will be issued per season; lost badges can be replaced subject to the Borough's standard fees.

- 3) Veterans:
 - a. Any individual who has served and was released through Honorable Discharge with at least 90-days of active duty service, or released from active duty service by reason of a service-incurred injury or disability are eligible for a free beach badge.
 - b. The qualifying Veteran must be present at the time of the request.

- c. Proper military-issued identification (i.e. DD214) must be presented and completion of the Cape May Point tracking form is required.
 - d. Only one free beach badge per veteran will be issued per season; lost badges can be replaced subject to the Borough's standard fees.
- 4) Issuance:
- a) Free Military Beach Badges will only be issued during the regular operating hours of the Beach Director's Office located at Borough Hall, 215 Lighthouse Avenue, Cape May Point, NJ.
 - b) Free Military Beach Badges are not available from the beach badge staff working on the beaches.
