WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Work Session of the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Cape May Point was called to order by Solicitor John Amenhauser at 12:00 PM. The Open Public Meetings Statement was read by Solicitor Amenhauser who then led those present in the flag salute. Commissioner Busch, Mayor Moffatt and Commissioner vanHeeswyk answered roll call. Also in attendance was Administrator Ed Grant.

COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS/DISCUSSIONS

Commissioner Busch reported that barring any supply chain issues, the Yale Avenue repaving project will begin mid-April with the replacement of storm drains.

Mayor Moffatt stated that we will be adjusting the hours of operation for our Lifeguards this year to align with the hours the Cape May city beaches are open.

Commissioner vanHeeswyk shared that the borough received a letter that was a tribute to Cape May Point from a former New Jersey resident that is now living in Kyiv, Ukraine. This letter was also sent to the Star and Wave newspaper and will be included in the Wednesday, March 23 edition.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Grant reported that there are vendors looking to renegotiate contracts because of the rise in gas prices. He and Solicitor Amenhauser will be addressing these requests as they come in. Mr. Grant also stated that we are actively looking for an energy consultant. Finally, he stated that the Borough staff has achieved 100% completion on cyber security awareness training.
