

MARCH 28, 2023
WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Work Session of the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Cape May Point was called to order by Clerk Wallace at 12:00 PM. The Open Public Meetings Statement was read by the Clerk who then led those present in the flag salute. Mayor Moffatt, Commissioner Busch and Commissioner vanHeeswyk answered roll call. Also in attendance: Administrator Ed Grant, Clerk Elaine Wallace, and Solicitor John Amenhauser. This meeting was held electronically via ZOOM under local operation guidance from the NJDCA pursuant to P.L. 2020, c.11.

COMMISSIONERS' DISCUSSION/REPORTS:

Commissioner Busch reported the seasonal staff in public works will be starting next week. Summer preparations will be done in April and May and Ms. Busch asked the public to be patient as it takes time to prepare the beach entrances, get the mats out, mulch, and do general cleanup.

Commissioner vanHeeswyk announced receipt of the long-awaited Watershed Management Plan. It was prepared by Dr. Stewart Farrell and done in collaboration with West Cape May and Cape May City as a cost-saving measure. It is a valuable document that can be used by the Environmental Commission, the Planning Board, and as a resource for the stormwater management plan. The public can find it on the Borough's Floodplain Manager page.

Mayor Moffatt reported the borough website has a link to the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority Waste Wizard app. People can download the app to get information on how to dispose of items in compliance with the County's recycling program. He also reminded everyone to recycling only empty, clean, and dry, loose bottles, jugs, jars, and containers (without lids) and to NEVER place recyclables in plastic bags.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

Mr. Grant reported the Borough is awaiting an answer from the County on its request for them to consider an interlocal service agreement for street sweeping. He also reported he had a productive annual meeting with Atlantic City Electric to discuss issues, concerns and share information.
