The Environmental Commission submitted our Mayors' Monarch
Pledge final report for 2025, and we recently received
notice from the National Wildlife Federation that
all NINE of our action items were approved!

Given the large number of action items that our community completed, for the first time in the five years that Cape May Point has participated in the MMP, we have been awarded "Leadership" status.

Thanks to all of you who planted native, nectar-rich flowers, added milkweed to your garden, and avoided using insecticides and systemic pesticides like neonictinoids, which are harmful to monarch butterflies and other pollinators.

Given our community's location on the monarch migratory path, all of the steps that you take to support and protect monarch butterflies is extremely important.
