NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCES**

[11-2026 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 113 “Nuisances, Public Health” of the Code of the Borough of Cape May Point](#)

In summary, this ordinance amends the Borough code to make the removal or confinement of bamboo a requirement for any property regardless of whether the bamboo originated on another property. It also requires the property owner to arrange for proper disposal of bamboo.
